Singers. For children, singing is one of the most natural things in the world. In 1991, when some elementary schools did not offer a children’s chorus, the NKCC created its first Youth Chorus. Today, the Youth Chorus can have as many as 50 singers. The children learn how to sing correctly while building their self-confidence and ability to work in teams.

Financial support for music programs in the North Kingstown School

Department. Our fund-raising efforts have provided \$44,500 for:

- Two new grand pianos for the high school
- An electronic piano for Quidnessett Elementary School
- Support for new risers in the High School choir room and auditorium
- New speakers for the High School auditorium
- 8 keyboards for the high school piano lab
- 12 choir robes for the NKHS concert choir
